

PARENTS / SUPPORTERS RESPONSIBILITIES.

St Ives Rangers wishes to promote fair conduct at all times and relies on parents / supporters to provide positive encouragement to all players, including opposition.

Parents / Supporters must be aware that their attitudes can have a significant bearing on the Players attitude towards other players, officials, managers and supporters.

Parents/supporters are encouraged to...

- Never ridicule, shout or scream at a young person – praise them and keep quiet.
- Set an example – applaud good play by both teams.
- Never publicly question the Referee's decisions and show respect at all times. Never doubt his or her honesty.
- Help to remove all verbal and physical abuse in football.
- Avoid coaching the player during the game.
- Recognise the value and importance of the coaches, who give up their time to help the young people.

Please remember...

- Young people are not playing to satisfy your ambition.
- Young people are involved for their enjoyment – not yours.
- You have a responsibility to encourage young people to play by the rules.
- Teamwork and effort are as important as winning. You should accept losing without undue disappointment.
- Do not allow your winning side to gloat over their victory.
